Who can enrol in Continuers Level courses?

These SACE courses are designed for students who:

- ◆ have achieved Year 10 level or equivalent for entry into SACE Stage 1
- ◆ have achieved SACE Stage 1 or equivalent for entry into SACE Stage 2.

Students considering studying a language at Continuers Level are strongly advised to complete Stage 1 before enrolling in a Stage 2 course.

SACE Board eligibility criteria apply to Chinese, Japanese, Korean and Vietnamese courses.
