## About Arabic

Arabic is spoken by approximately 280 million people in 22 countries over two continents. More than 370,000 Australians are of Arab descent. Arabic language and culture represent an important part of the linguistic and cultural diversity of Australia. The Arabic-speaking community has made and continues to make a significant contribution to the development and enrichment of Australian society, in areas such as commerce, agriculture, industry, health, education, journalism, tourism and international relations.

The demand for Arabic language education in Australia has increased due to the geopolitical importance of the Arabic-speaking world and greater awareness of business opportunities. Today, speakers of Arabic come from a variety of social, cultural and religious backgrounds.

Modern Standard Arabic is common to all countries of the Arabic-speaking world, while colloquial Arabic varies according to geographical location.

The Australian Curriculum: Languages – Arabic (Reception-Year 10) is pitched to background language learners, the dominant cohort of learners in the Australian context.

## How much does it cost?

The following annual charges apply:

### Government school students

- Reception - Year 7: \$125
- Year 10: \$125
- Years 11-12: \$150
- 8-10 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$760
- Years 11-12 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$840\*

### Non-government school students

- Reception - Year 7: \$125
- Year 10: \$125
- Years 11-12: \$150
- 8-10 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$1150
- Years 11-12 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$1250\*

\*Full fee-paying overseas students studying a language in addition to a full subject load must pay on enrolment.
