


Who are we?

About Persian

The Number of people in Australia who speak this language at home: 62,340 (ABS Census Data, 2011).

Persian is an official language in Iran, Afghanistan and Tajikistan where it is known as Farsi, Dari and Tajiki respectively. Persian has a rich cultural history evident in body of literature which includes poetry and epic works. Persian is written with the Arabic script.

Continuers level languages are designed for students who have studied the language for 400 to 500 hours by the time they have completed Stage 2, or who have an equivalent level of knowledge.

In studying these languages, students interact with others to share information, ideas, opinions and experiences. Students create texts in the specific language to express information, feelings, ideas and opinions. They analyse texts to interpret meaning, and examine relationships between language, culture and identity, and reflect on the ways in which culture influences communication.

How much does it cost?

Government school students

- Years 11-12: \$150
- Years 11-12 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$840*

Non-government school students

- Years 11-12: \$150
- Years 11-12 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$1250*

*Full fee-paying overseas students studying a language in addition to a full subject load must pay on enrolment.
