Who can enrol in Beginners Level courses?

These SACE courses are designed for secondary school students who:

- ◆ are in years 10, 11 or 12
- ◆ have no knowledge of the language
- ◆ wish to sit for an exam at Stage 2 for an ATAR.

Students must do Stage 1 before entering Stage 2 for examination purposes. Neither Stage can be repeated. SACE Board eligibility criteria apply.

How much does it cost?

The following annual charges apply:

Government school students

- Years 11-12: \$150
- 8-10 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$760
- Years 11-12 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$840*

Non-government school students

- Years 11-12: \$150
- 8-10 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$1150
- Years 11-12 Full fee-paying overseas student: \$1250*

*Full fee-paying overseas students studying a language in addition to a full subject load must pay on enrolment.

**These Languages are also available as IB ab initio subjects for students enrolled in IB schools.
