When can students enrol?

Only students who have turned 5 before the 1 May are eligible to enrol.

Enrolments for students in R-7 are accepted as follows:

Term 1 – ongoing basis

Terms 2 - 4 – until the end of Week 2 each term

Enrolment enquiries made after Term 4, Week 2 will be held over until the new school year.
