Osaka

Osaka (大阪市) is the second largest city in Japan, with over 10 million inhabitants.



In Osaka you will visit the Osaka Castle. Construction started on Osaka Castle in the year 1583 and for 50 years it was the largest castle in all Japan and the centre of the Japanese government. Today the park is one of Osaka's most popular hanami spots during the cherry blossom season, which usually takes place in early April.



Kyoto (京都) This is a city of some 2000 temples and shrines; a city of true masterpieces of religious architecture, such as the splendour of the famed Golden Pavilion and the cavernous expanse of Higashi Hongan-ji. This is where robed monks shuffle between temple buildings, prayer chants resonate through stunning Zen gardens, and the faithful meditate on tatami-mat floors. Even as the modern city buzzes and shifts all around, a waft of burning incense is a regular reminder that Kyoto remains the spiritual heart of Japan.

Kobe



Kobe (福岡) The city of Kobe is located on the island of Honshu and is known for being one of the most vibrant cities in Japan. The city is located on a scenic harbor and also has its own mountain which offers sweeping views across the region.


Kobe is also known for its devastating earthquake which hit in 1995 and raised parts of the city to the ground. Now you can visit a range of memorials that are dedicated to honouring those who lost their lives during this challenging period of Kobe's history. Perched on a hillside sloping down to the sea, Kobe is one of Japan's most attractive and cosmopolitan cities. It was a maritime gateway from the earliest days of trade with China and home to one of the first foreign settlements after Japan reopened to the world in the mid-19th century.
