

**Communique for Parents/Carers: 6<sup>th</sup> May 2020**

Dear parents/carers,

Online learning went quite well in Week 1, and is continuing for many of our classes this week.

We are gradually returning to face to face classes; and, as notified in the previous Communique, we will inform you via SMS of when this will occur for your children.

Please note that we continue to follow SA Health and the Department for Education advice, and as face to face classes resume we will be wiping down desks with sanitiser and reminding students to:

- Wash their hands before and after lessons, when they go to toilet and during the break.
- Cough/sneeze into their elbows or into a tissue (and dispose of it immediately).
- Maintain distance from others, as far as it is practical.
- Not come to class if they are sick.
- Not come to class if they are a confirmed Covid-19 case, or if they have been instructed to self-isolate; in which case we must be informed.

We would also like to remind you to notify us in advance if your child is going to be absent.

For those of you who usually accompany your children to class, we ask that you do not enter the school grounds.

These measures will all help to maintain student and staff safety.

I wish to thank you in anticipation for observing these important measures, which all contribute to maintaining student and staff safety.
