SASSL SCORES OUTSTANDING 1990 PES RESULTS

The School Council of SASSL wrote to the Minister of Education to inform him of the outstanding results achieved by SASSL students in 1990. Of some 270 students who sat for PES Examinations in 10 languages 96% passed. It was noted that an absolute 85% of students scored an "A" or "B" grade. Twenty students were awarded SSABSA Certificates of Merit.
