#### Message from the new Principal -Ms Lee Knight



I wish to introduce myself to you all as the new Principal of the School of Languages. My appointment is temporary, Until July 2022 at this stage, whilst Lia is on extended leave.

I extend a very warm welcome to all members of the school community for the 2022 school year; and a particularly warm welcome to students and parents who have joined the school for the first time.

This year, like the last 2 years, we are working through the challenges that Covid-19 presents. You will be aware that this has changed how classes will be delivered for the start of the year. However, I am confident in the skills of my teaching staff that your child will still receive a high-quality language education.

Last year's excellent SACE results, despite a Covid interrupted year, are testament to the resilience and flexibility shown by our school community. Read more about these results below.

#### **Year 12 Results**

We would like to congratulate our year 12 students who studied either a SACE or an International Baccalaureate language course with us last year.

**SACE:** 265 students in total completed a SACE Stage 2 language; 99% of our students achieved a passing grade, C- or above, with 92% of them achieving an A or B:

- 53% achieved an A grade
- 39% achieved a B grade

An incredible 24 students, or 9%, achieved an A+ grade. This is a credit to these students, their family support and their teachers at the School of Languages as this is 5% above the state average for A+ grades.

The following students deserve a special mention for receiving an A+ with Merit, meaning they have achieved exceptional achievement in the subject. Due to Covid, the Merit Ceremony at Government House has been postponed till a later date this year.

Our state government funded SACE holiday program, known as *Let's Talk!* will be offered again for secondary students, during the April holidays. Further information will be available soon on our website.




#### Languages Alive!


