WHY ENROL?

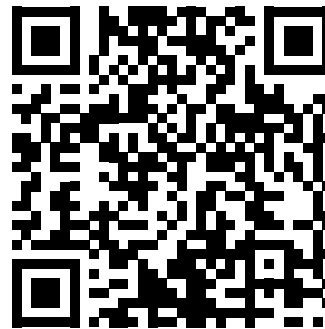
- * Courses offered out-of-school hours without clashing with your day school's timetable.

WHAT CURRICULUM IS TAUGHT?

R-6 language courses are based on the Australian Curriculum. Teachers will differentiate learning experiences for their students to cater for learner differences.

WHEN CAN STUDENTS ENROL?

Enrolments for R-6 students are accepted as follows:

Term 1 – ongoing basis

Term 2 & 3 – to end of Week 2 each term

Enrolment enquiries made after Term 3, Week 2 will be held over until the new school year.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The following annual charge applies per language:

R-6: \$150

R-6 International full fee-paying students:

Government School students; \$720

Non-Government School students; \$1150

PLEASE NOTE:

Only students who have turned 5 before the 1st May are eligible to enrol in Reception.
