There were many entries, which made the selection of winners very difficult for the judging panel!








Felix Orinuela – Reception Spanish





Year 12 Examinations

Most of our Year 12 students will sit their final exams within the next few weeks. Students have been given details regarding the date, time and venue for their oral and written exams.

The updated timetable is provided in this newsletter.

All students of Year 12 IB had their last lesson for the year in Week 10 of Term 3. SACE students who have exams during Term 4 Week 1 also have their last lesson for the year in Week 10 Term 3. This applies to: Bosnian Continuers, Croatian Continuers, French Beginners, German Beginners, Hindi Continuers, Japanese Beginners, Khmer Continuers, Korean Beginners, Nepali Continuers. Persian Continuers, Polish Continuers, Punjabi Continuers, and Serbian Continuers.

Final lessons for students of other courses are provided in the Key Dates section of this newsletter.

Year 12 SACE students must be aware that it is not possible to catch up with a missed written and/or oral exam. Students who do not attend their scheduled exam(s) will need to present a doctor's certificate using the SACE Board's proforma; or receive a zero mark for this part of the exam. A doctor's certificate stating that a student was 'unable to attend the exam due to a medical condition' will not be sufficient.

Enrolling for 2024

Our 2024 promotional information is being distributed to all schools and community groups, together with enrolment forms. Enrolment information is also on our school web site.

Re-enrolment of students, Reception-Year 9

We distributed a letter outlining our reenrolment process for 2024 to all students currently enrolled in Reception to Year 9 in Term 3 Week 9 in class. If your student is absent in Week 9, this information will be posted home. These students will be automatically re-enrolled for the next year level, unless we are advised otherwise by **Friday 10 November (Week 5)**.

Re-enrolment of students, Years 10 and 11

We sent parents/carers of all students currently enrolled in Year 10 and SACE Stage 1 an SMS in Term 2 Week 9 with a link to our website where there is information outlining our re-enrolment process for 2024. This process took place in Term 3 Week 6. Students who intend to continue studying with us in 2024 will receive a Letter of Acknowledgement in Term 3 Week 9 in class, and a Confirmation of Re-enrolment letter in Term 4 Week 6/7 in class. If your student is absent in the relevant weeks, this information will be posted home.
