Arabic is spoken by approximately 280 million people in 22 countries over two continents.

More than 370,000 Australians are of Arab descent. Arabic language and culture represent an important part of the linguistic and cultural diversity of Australia. The Arabic-speaking community has made and continues to make a significant contribution to the development and enrichment of Australian society, in areas such as commerce, agriculture, industry, health, education, journalism, tourism and international relations.

The demand for Arabic language education in Australia has increased due to the geopolitical importance of the Arabic-speaking world and greater awareness of business opportunities.

Today, speakers of Arabic come from a variety of social, cultural and religious backgrounds.
