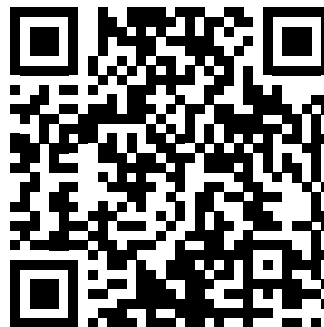

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The following annual charges apply:

Government School Students

Stage 1/2 SACE students: \$180

Years 11-12 International full fee-paying student: \$1000*

Non-Government School Students

Stage 1/2 SACE students: \$180

Years 11-12 International full fee-paying student: \$1350*

***For students studying the language in addition to a full subject load, the subject charge is to be paid before attending classes.**

WHO CAN ENROL IN CONTINUERS LEVEL COURSES?

These SACE courses are designed for students who:

- * have achieved Year 10 level or equivalent for entry into SACE Stage 1
- * have achieved SACE Stage 1 Continuers or equivalent for entry into SACE Stage 2.
- * Students considering studying a language at Continuers Level are strongly advised to complete Stage 1 before enrolling in a Stage 2 course.
- * SACE Board eligibility criteria apply to Chinese, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean and Vietnamese courses.
