

*For students studying the language in addition to a full subject load, the subject charge is to be paid before attending classes.

WHO CAN ENROL IN CONTINUERS LEVEL COURSES?

These SACE courses are designed for students who:

- have achieved Year 10 level or equivalent for entry into SACE Stage 1
- have achieved SACE Stage 1 Continuers or equivalent for entry into SACE Stage 2.
- * Students considering studying a language at Continuers Level are strongly advised to complete Stage 1 before enrolling in a Stage 2 course.
- * SACE Board eligibility criteria apply to Chinese, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean and Vietnamese courses.
