WHY ENROL?

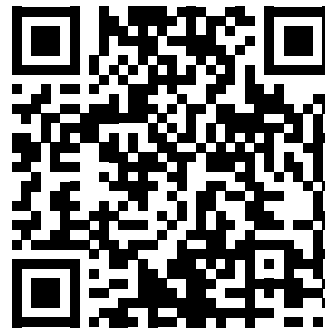

ABOUT CROATIAN

Croatian is spoken in countries that have been historically the ethnic Croatian homelands, and in many other countries where Croatians live today, for example: Italy, Slovakia, Romania, Austria, Germany, Sweden, South and North America, New Zealand and Australia.

The Croatian culture and language have influenced other regional cultures and have contributed significantly to fields of knowledge such as science and technology, literature, music, the visual arts, religion and philosophy.

The study of Croatian gives access to this rich cultural and linguistic heritage.

Years 7-10 courses are based on the Australian Curriculum: Languages. Teachers will use the curriculum to cater for learners of different backgrounds by making appropriate adjustments to differentiate learning experiences for these students.

In Years 11-12, Croatian is available at Continuers level, and contributes 10 SACE credits in Stage 1 Semester 1, and another 10 in Semester 2. At Stage 2, successful completion of the course provides 20 SACE credits as well as 2 bonus ATAR points for entry into all three South Australian universities.
