ABOUT POLISH

Polish is a major Slavonic language, spoken by over 50 million people worldwide, with a long tradition as a literary language dating back to the tenth century.

Polish influence is visible in Australia since the early days of European exploration, particularly in Australian history and geography. Mount Kosciuszko was named by Paul Edmond Strzelecki, a Polish explorer, and the Strzelecki Track was named after him.

Since 1989, the opportunities for trade, travel and cultural exchange between Poland and Australia have greatly increased. Career prospects in interpreting and translating, community welfare or in the diplomatic service make Polish a relevant language for students in Australia.

Poland has been a member of the European Union since 2004, creating opportunities for Polishspeaking Australian graduates to seek work in European companies that have an industry base in Poland. A number of notable Australian companies are also present in Poland.

Polish has been taught at the School of Languages since the School was established in 1986, with enrolment numbers peaking in the early 1990s and remaining steady since then.
