## **MY LANGUAGE LEARNING JOURNEY**

### **COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

#### **1. Who is eligible?**

The competition is open to all R-12 students enrolled at the School of Languages. The entrants will be categorised according to four groups:

Category A: Junior Primary (R-3 students)

Category B: Primary (Years 4-6)

Category C: Middle Years (Years 7-9)

Category D: Senior Secondary (Years 10-12)

#### **2. What do you have to do to enter?**

Create a presentation in whatever format you choose that reflects this year's theme; **My Language Learning Journey**

This includes:

- Poster (No larger than A2 size)
- Story
- Song
- Video
- Social media clip
- Poem
- Reflection (English)

1. All entries must include one or more languages taught at the School of Languages
2. Each entry must be the original work of the student (including creative artwork, illustrations and images); *no group entries will be accepted.*

#### **Electronic entries**

In addition to points 1- 2 above, any programs used for the design elements of an e-entry must be declared on the Competition Entry and Declaration form (see attached).

## Helpful hints

Some thought starters for your design:

- How does it feel to be multilingual? Tell us about your journey.
- What motivates you to learn a language?
- What are you most proud of?

Get creative! Use humour! Be playful! Find a unique angle!

### 3. What are the prizes?

- All entrants will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- Two winning entries from each category will be selected.
- Winners from all categories will receive \$100 prize money and a Certificate of Excellence.
- All competition winners will be acknowledged on our Website, Social Media platforms.

### 4. Competition entry and declaration form

The winning entries must meet all the requirements in these Guidelines. Entries will be judged on the level of originality, impact, and how creatively they've expressed and explored the theme: **My Language Learning Journey**.

All entries must be an individual student's original creation. Three-dimensional entries will not be accepted. The Competition Entry and Declaration Form must be submitted with every entry to be eligible.

- Art paper used must be made of flexible material so that it can be rolled up in a mailing tube. Please roll up with poster side facing outward. Do not fold the poster.
- Multimedia Presentations must use standard video formats - .mp4, .mov, .mkv, .ppt, .pptx, H264, H265.
- For 2D files use photoshop, illustrator, .jpeg or .pdf.
- Selection of winners will be made by a judging panel with representatives from the Governing Council and the School of Languages student body.
- Winners will be notified in writing by the end of September 2024.

### 5. When does the competition start?

Competition entries are open from **Monday 1 July until Friday 30 August 2024**.

### 6. How do you submit your entry?

Entries can be mailed, emailed, personally dropped off at the School of Languages reception area or uploaded to your class Team (accompanied by an email to Steve Milazzo) by **4pm on the 30<sup>th</sup> August 2024**. Late entries will not be eligible.

### 7. What are the conditions of the competition?

Entrants agree to be bound by the competition guidelines and the decisions of the School of Languages judging panel. They also accept all responsibility for late, lost, misdirected or ineligible entries.
